PUBLIC HOUSING MINISTRY

St Jude's Carlton

One of the ways that people are marginalised in Australia is technologically. So while

churches, including St. Jude's, turned to live streaming and Zoom during lockdown these were not options which everyone could access. St. Jude's Estate's Community Church includes many people who not only don't have computers or know how to use them, but don't even have smart phones. We have responded to that by providing church services using text messaging. The challenge here is to present the gospel in narrow strings of text where sermons are measured in millimetres rather than minutes. The blessings are that we can send them to an ex congregant who lives in an aged care facility in Rochester in northern Victoria and a church member can forward them to a friend in Maroopna.

All of our Iranian congregants however do have smart phones so we are using Whatsapp to provide them with a Sunday service. One of our members, Samira, writes the liturgy in Farsi and I record the sermon and post it as an audio file.

With both Sunday services, as has been the case with our previous live services on the public housing estate, simple language is the key.

Many public tenants have limited education and refugees generally have limited fluency in English. The very good news is that glory of God's revelation of himself in Christ Jesus can be proclaimed in ribbons of simple words, in any language and any format. Words of life don't need verbosity or grand display only truth.
