COLLECT

A reading from the book of Exodus

The Lord said to Moses, 'Cut two tablets of stone like the former ones, and I will write on the tablets the words that were on the former tablets, which you broke. Be ready in the morning, and come up in the morning to Mount Sinai and present yourself there to me, on the top of the mountain. No one shall come up with you, and do not let anyone be seen throughout all the mountain; and do not let flocks or herds graze in front of that mountain.' So Moses cut two tablets of stone like the former ones; and he rose early in the morning and went up on Mount Sinai, as the Lord had commanded him, and took in his hand the two tablets of stone. 



Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey everything that I have commanded you. And remember, I am with you always, to the end of the age.'



PRESENTATION OF THOMAS MONTEITH FOR BAPTISM

The Minister addresses the whole congregation

Faith is the gift of God to his people. In baptism the Lord is adding to our number those whom he is calling. People of God, will you welcome *Thomas Ziming Monteith* and uphold him in his new life in Christ?

(All answer) With the help of God, we will.

The Minister then says to the parents and godparents

Parents and godparents, the Church receives Thomas with joy. Today we are trusting God for his growth in faith. Will you pray for him, draw him by your example into the community of faith and walk with him in the way of Christ? (God)parents With the help of God, we will.

In baptism *Thomas* begins his journey in faith. You speak for *him* today. Will you care for *him*, and help *him* to take *his* place within the life and worship of Christ's Church?

(God)parents With the help of God, we will.

THE DECISION

The Minister addresses the candidates through their parents, godparents and sponsors In baptism, God calls us out of darkness into his marvellous light. To follow Christ means dying to sin and rising to new life with him. Therefore I ask:

Minister Do you turn to Christ?

(God)parents I turn to Christ.

Minister Do you repent of your sins?

(God)parents I repent of my sins.

Minister Do you renounce evil?

(God)parents I renounce evil.

SIGNING WITH THE CROSS

The Minister makes the sign of the cross on the forehead of Thomas, saying

Christ claims you for his own.

Receive the sign of his cross.

Do not be ashamed to confess the faith of Christ crucified.

Fight valiantly as a disciple of Christ against sin, the world and the devil, and remain faithful to Christ to the end of your life.

May almighty God deliver you from the powers of darkness, restore in you the image of his glory, and lead you in the light and obedience of Christ. **Amen.**

PRAYER OVER THE WATER

The servers, clergy and baptismal party gather at the baptismal font.

Praise God who made heaven and earth, who keeps his promise for ever.
Let us give thanks to the Lord our God.
It is right to give thanks and praise.

Father, we give you thanks and praise for your gift of water in creation; for your Spirit, sweeping over the waters, bringing light and life; for your Son Jesus Christ our Lord, baptized in the river Jordan.

We bless you for your new creation, brought to birth by water and the Spirit, and for your grace bestowed upon us your children, washing away our sins.

May your holy and life-giving Spirit move upon these waters.
Restore through them the beauty of your creation, and bring those who are baptized to new birth in the family of your Church.

Drown sin in the waters of judgement, anoint your children with power from on high, and make them one with Christ in the freedom of your kingdom. For all might, majesty, dominion and power are yours, now and for ever.

Amen.

PROFESSION OF FAITH

The Minister says

Let us affirm our common faith in Jesus Christ.

Do you believe and trust in God the Father, source of all being and life, the one for whom we exist?

I believe and trust in him.

Do you believe and trust in God the Son, who took our human nature, died for us and rose again?

I believe and trust in him.

Do you believe and trust in God the Holy Spirit, who gives life to the people of God and makes Christ known in the world?

I believe and trust in him.

This is the faith of the Church.

This is our faith.

We believe and trust in one God, Father, Son and Holy Spirit.

BAPTISM

The Minister pours water on Thomas saying Thomas Ziming Monteith, I baptize you in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit.

Amen.

The Minister says

May God, who has received you by baptism into his Church, pour upon you the riches of his grace, that within the company of Christ's pilgrim people you may daily be renewed by his anointing Spirit, and come to the inheritance of the saints in glory.

Amen.

GIVING OF A LIGHTED CANDLE

A lighted candle is given to Thomas.

God has delivered us from the dominion of darkness and has given us a place with the saints in light. You have received the light of Christ; walk in this light all the days of your life.

Shine as a light in the world to the glory of God the Father.


THE WELCOME AND GREETING OF PEACE
