This free concert has been planned in close consultation with Angela's parents Mario and Rosa, and sisters Kathryn and Francesca.

Angela touched the lives of a great number of people in diverse ways, particularly through her love of music and performance. This concert to honour Angela has enabled Angela's friends and others under the direction of Mr Peter McKay to demonstrate the power of music to celebrate life.

Esteemed Australian architects Frederick Romberg and Robin Boyd designed and created this church in 1963-64. They sought with their design to create a building where what went on inside shone out to the world. Archbishop Woods at the churches dedication on 7th November 1964 said that Romberg and Boyd had created a space that enabled "the Church to care for people in body, mind and soul". This evening through the gift of music and friendship, coupled with this building's fine design and acoustic, the power of music in a sacred space will demonstrate that care of body, mind and soul.
