

Frederick Romberg and Robin Boyd's masterful St George Peace Memorial Church has sat at the heart of East Ivanhoe since 1964. At the dedication service of the Church in November 1964 the then Anglican Archbishop of Melbourne (Abp Penman) remarked that the vision of the community and the architects was that they had created a space in which to care for people in body, mind and soul. Indeed people have been welcomed unconditionally to not only our church, but also to our courtyard, garden of remembrance, Opportunity Shop, Evans Hall, Upper Hall and Parish Meeting Room for nearly 60 years as a diversity of community groups and small businesses use the full range of our facilities to care for people in body, mind and soul.

During the time of COVID restrictions it was a pleasure to see how many people used our garden of remembrance, courtyard and the small park between church and our neighbours to meet friends and family. It is a particular joy to welcome the children from our neighbours, Ivanhoe East State Primary School, each afternoon after school into our courtyard as they run around and play, and even the teenagers who occasionally 'hang out' and sit in the sun on our rear deck.

We share this booklet with you so that you might gain a sense of this church that sits of the heart of the village. You are welcome to visit us at any time. Why not drop in to our Opportunity Shop, which supports about 23 local not for profit community organisations as well as the church itself. You might also like to visit or join one of the many groups who use our facilities, or even start a group yourself.

At the moment we are looking for people who might like to keep the church open during the day to provide a place of hospitality and welcome to those who may lack regular social contact. As summer approaches, and the church remains cool, it may be that you will find people to talk to and rest, and so save your electricity bills on air conditioning.

As Spring and Summer approach you are invited to visit this sacred space, and maybe even attend one of the many events advertised in this booklet. It is our joy to continue be the church at the heart of the village caring for all in body, mind and soul.
